Coming Soon: Easy Rides R24

We have a major new release of Easy Rides in the final stages of testing. This release adds support for our newest product, Easy Rides Starter, a low cost version of Easy Rides for systems with fewer than 10 routes and 10 vehicles. It also replaces the control center with a unified dispatch and planner board letting you get to your routes and rides faster. Watch for more info on the release of this update in the coming week.

System Spotlight: Montrose County Transit, Montrose, CO

Montrose County has only been using Easy Rides for a few months, but they have already doubled their capacity going from about 1400 trips per month to over 3000! They have also switched to live dispatching recording rides as the driver calls them in, saving time entering mileage at the end of the day. Great work Montrose!

Have a trip you want to keep your eye on? You can mark a trip with different colors by changing the first character in the trip note. This will make the time for the ticket change on the dispatch board. The symbols and there colors are as follows:

	2310 North Pole	< Red
	2310 World Tour	> Blue

	2311 World Tour	~ Brown
